

THE LACEY ACT – REVISED FOR 2024

You Need to Review Your Imports.

What do YOU need to do?

By December 1, 2024 - ALL Importers are **required to submit a separate Lacey Declaration** for applicable products (tariffs),* on each shipment. Failure to make a proper declaration can result in a penalty up to \$10,000.

What is the Lacey Act?

The Lacey Act is a conservation law enacted in 1900 to prohibit the trade of fish, wildlife, and plants that have been illegally taken, possessed, transported, or sold.

In 2008 it was substantially modified, **requiring ANY imported product** with “plant based material” (wood, seeds, leaves, etc.) **to have a “Lacey Declaration,”** that states the **genus, species, and country of harvest** of the plant material.

***New products requiring declaration as of December 1, 2024:** industrial or medicinal plants, essential oils, handbags, plywood, laminated wood, tools, matches with natural wood stems, products of natural cork, products of bamboo & rattan, footwear, & more.
